1. Vente-unique.com's Commitments

We respect the privacy of our users and ensure that all information collected that identifies them is treated as confidential information. In accordance with this, we are committed to:

- Strictly complying with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of personal data (**UK GDPR**), the **Data Protection Act 2018**, and the **Data Use and Access Act 2025 (DUAA)**.
- Strictly complying with the **Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR)**.
- Implementing all appropriate measures regarding information and the collection of your consent for the placement of cookies on your device (in accordance with the PECR).

2. Privacy Policy Regarding Personal Data

The aim of this policy is to present the User with the reasons why personal data is collected by Vente-unique.com, how it is used, and the options available to the User to object to such uses. Collected data is used within the limits permitted by law. Vente-unique.com pays particular attention to the protection of the User's personal information and undertakes to comply with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council regarding the protection of personal data (hereinafter **UK GDPR**).

Preliminary Definitions

The following definitions apply to this Policy:

- **"Customer"**: refers to any individual who accesses the Site, is registered, and places an order on the Site.
- **"Data"** or **"Personal Data"**: refers to personal data undergoing Processing under this Privacy Policy, as defined in Article 4(1) of the UK GDPR.
- **"General Data Protection Regulation"** or **"GDPR"**: refers to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons regarding the Processing of Personal Data and on the free movement of such Data.
- **"Data Controller"**: refers to the person who determines the purposes and means of Processing in accordance with Article 4(7) of the UK GDPR and Section 6 of the Data Protection Act 2018.
- **"Site"**: refers to the Vente-unique.com website accessible at the following address: [Vente-unique.co.uk](https://vente-unique.co.uk).
- **"Data Processor"**: refers to the natural or legal person, public authority, agency, or other body which Processes Personal Data on behalf of and according to the instructions of the Data Controller, in accordance with Article 4(8) of the UK GDPR.
- **"Processing/Process"**: refers to any operation referred to in Article 4(2) of the UK

GDPR, performed on Personal Data within the scope of implementing this Privacy Policy.

- **"User"**: refers to any person who accesses and browses the Site, whether they are a Customer or a casual visitor.

Who is Responsible for Protecting Your Data?

Further Information Regarding the Data Protection Officer:

The mission of the Data Protection Officer is to inform, advise, and monitor the compliance of Vente-unique.com in the performance of its data processing operations.

In accordance with data protection regulations, the DPO shall act as the primary point of contact:

- For Data Subjects: regarding any matter relating to the processing of data carried out by Vente-unique.com or the exercise of your statutory rights;
- For Supervisory Authorities: specifically, the CNIL in France and the ICO (Information Commissioner's Office) in the United Kingdom, as part of their duty to cooperate. The DPO may also contact these authorities to seek an opinion or prior consultation on any matters concerning the protection of personal data;
- For other DPOs: appointed by third-party Data Processors or participating Data Controllers.

How Do We Collect Your Data?

As a general principle, all Data concerning the User is collected directly from the User, for instance, during registration on the Site, through correspondence with Vente-unique.com, when placing an order, creating an account, requesting contact or information, subscribing to the Newsletter, or while browsing the Site.

Data relating to your browsing activity on the Site may be used to identify your needs and interests and to tailor our commercial and advertising offers accordingly.

In the event of a Newsletter subscription, the User has the option to **opt out** of marketing communications in every email or SMS. What Data is Collected?

Requested data marked with an asterisk is mandatory for the successful processing of the order or the service requested by the User. The provision of this data is a requirement for entering into a contract. Should the User wish to place an order or request a service, they are required to provide this information. In the absence of such data, Vente-unique.com will be unable to fulfill the order or perform the service requested by the User.

Who Has Access to My Data?

The Data collected by the Site is intended for Vente-unique.com and its subsidiaries, parent companies, or entities under common control. The concept of "control" is understood as defined in Article L. 233-3 of the French Commercial Code and is exercised for the purposes of performing the services (e.g., order fulfilment or delivery). The Site may transfer Data to its subsidiaries and affiliates, or to third parties in the event of a merger, acquisition, insolvency, dissolution, reorganisation, or any similar transaction.

Data collected by the Site may be transferred to third-party Data Processors for the purposes of performing the services. In such cases, these third-party Processors act on behalf of Vente-unique.com and undertake to comply with Vente-unique.com's instructions as well as the provisions of this Privacy Policy.

These third-party Processors use and process the Data to ensure the successful execution of the service requested by the User. For example: information regarding the Customer's postal address is shared to enable third-party logistics providers to deliver the order to the Customer's home.

The third-party Processors and partners engaged by Vente-unique.com have committed to complying with the provisions of the UK GDPR. The Site will implement the necessary security measures and ensure that the third parties it engages adhere to the personal data protection rules established by the aforementioned Regulation.

The Site may transfer and share User Data:

- With third-party Processors acting on behalf of Vente-unique.com to ensure the proper execution of the service requested by the User;
- When Vente-unique.com has received the User's **express consent** to transfer Data to a third-party partner (e.g., advertisers), for instance by ticking a box allowing Vente-unique.com to share Data with such partners;
- Following a formal summons or legal request issued by an authority to Vente-unique.com to disclose said Data;
- In the event of suspicion by the Site regarding fraud, security issues, or technical problems, Vente-unique.com may share Data with the relevant competent bodies;
- In the event of a **legitimate interest** for Vente-unique.com (e.g., transferring Data within the group of companies to which Vente-unique.com belongs to ensure network and information security, or transferring Data to state authorities to highlight criminal offences or threats to public safety).

Is My Data Transferred Outside the European Union?

Data is transferred to the following countries: France, the United Kingdom (solely regarding payment information), and Tunisia.

When Data is transferred outside the European Economic Area (EEA), Vente-unique.com implements appropriate safeguards, notably using **Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs)** to ensure an identical level of protection for User Data. The User may request details of these measures:

How Long Is My Data Retained?

We retain your Data only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected, as described below:

Retention Period

For the duration of the contractual relationship, then stored in secure archives for the duration of the applicable statutory limitation period (five (5) years for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims). Connection logs and action history are kept for a period not exceeding six (6) months. For credit card payments, in accordance with the French Monetary and Financial Code, data may be stored as evidence in the event of a transaction dispute or claim, in secure archives, for thirteen (13) months following the debit date (extended to 15 months for deferred debit cards).

Invoice Management

The PAN and CVV (security code) are not stored. Invoices and accounting data are retained for ten (10) years from the date of issue.

Order Dispatch

For the time necessary to process the request, then stored in secure archives for two (2) years following the last contact with Vente-

What Are Your Rights Under the UK GDPR and Data Protection Act 2018, and How Can You Exercise Them?

In accordance with applicable regulations, every User has the following rights:

- **Right of Access** (Article 15 UK GDPR): The right to obtain a copy of your personal data;

- **Right to Rectification** (Article 16 UK GDPR): The right to update or correct inaccurate or incomplete personal data;
 - **Right to Erasure (The Right to be Forgotten)** (Article 17 UK GDPR): The right to have your personal data deleted when it is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected;
 - **Right to Withdraw Consent** (Article 13-2 c d UK GDPR): The right to withdraw your consent at any time where processing is based on consent;
 - **Right to Restriction of Processing** (Article 18 UK GDPR): The right to limit the way an organisation uses your data;
 - **Right to Data Portability** (Article 20 UK GDPR): The right to receive the personal data you provided in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format;
 - **Right to Object** (Article 21 UK GDPR): The right to object to the processing of your data in certain circumstances.
